What: make first-of-its-kind ventilation device to ease mild breathing issues

When: published on 16th September 2020

A group of seven engineering students from IIIT, Bhubaneswar claimed to have developed a first-ofits-kind helmet-like ventilation device that benefits patients suffering from mild respiratory distress. It can also act as a comfortable alternative to the suffocating PPE kits, the students claimed.Shaped as a bubble enclosure for the head, the device works on the principle of hyperbaric oxygen therapy mostly used for treating diving-related illness and some other medical conditions.

Inside a hyperbaric chamber, a person is made to inhale almost pure oxygen to speed up body's healing process. Some researchers believe the therapy can also be useful for treating respiratory diseases. Though the therapy is used in a wide variety of medical conditions, experts often express doubts regarding adequate scientific validation of its efficacy or safety. In this therapy, the patient is made to breathe oxygen in the pressurised chamber. The atmospheric pressure inside the chamber is raised up to three times higher than normal.(Read more)

What: approves Alstom"s acquisition of Bombardier Transportation

When: published on 20th September 2020

Fair trade regulator CCI has approved acquisition of sole control over Bombardier Transportation, the global rail solutions division of Bombardier, by Alstom S.A. In addition, the regulator has also given approval to Caisse de dépôt et placement du Québec (CDPQ) and Bombardier Inc for picking 18 per cent and 3 per cent stake in Alstom, respectively, a press release said. Alstom is a French corporation globally active in the rail transport industry. In India, it manufactures and supplies signalling solutions, rail electrification, rolling stock, track works, maintenance services and also provides associated construction and engineering services through its subsidiaries, the release noted. Bombardier Inc is a Canadian firm, globally active in the business aircraft and the rail transport industries while CDPQ is a global long-term institutional investor, it added. Separately, the Competition Commission of India (CCI) also gave nod to acquisition of sole control over DuPont de Nemours Inc''s Nutrition and Bio-sciences business by International Flavors and Fragrances (IFF). According to a combination notice filed with the regulator, the proposed combination relates to the acquisition of sole control by IFF, over the Nutrition and Biosciences business of DuPont, by means of acquiring sole control over SpinCo, a



company newly formed by DuPont and to which DuPont will transfer the Nutrition and Biosciences business. The proposed transaction involves the combination of two largely complementary businesses in the food and beverage, home and personal care, and health and wellness markets, it added. In a tweet on Friday, the regulator said that the "Commission approves acquisition of sole control by International Flavors & Fragrances over Nutrition & Bio-sciences business of DuPont."(Read more)

The decision was taken during the 50th DG level conference of the border guarding forces of India and Bangladesh which concluded in Dhaka on Saturday. A joint record of discussion was issued on the final day of the conference on Saturday.

Recognising the increasingly violent attacks on the border guarding forces, both the countries agreed for real time sharing of intelligence on smuggling syndicates and list of smugglers to ensure that the India-Bangladesh border remains peaceful and secure.(Read more)
