The GMR Group-led Rajiv Gandhi International Airport here has been granted the Airport Health Accreditation (AHA) by ACI, a worldwide association for the air transport industry, for the safety measures being takenat the aerodrome, the operator said on Sunday.

It is among the first airports in Asia Pacific region to have received this coveted accreditation by the Airport Council International (ACI), a release from the GMR said. The accreditation is the outcome of the rigorous assessment of the RGIA on the alignment of its health measures with the ACI Aviation Business Restart and Recovery guidelines and ICAO (International Civil Aviation Organisation) Council Aviation Recovery Task Force (CART) Recommendations along with industry best practices, it said.(Read more)

What: prescribes five-pillared approach to deal with cybersecurity issues in UCBs

When: published on 24th September 2020

The Reserve Bank on Thursday came out with a five-pillared strategic approach 'GUARD' to deal with cybersecurity threats being faced by urban cooperative banks (UCBs).

The number, frequency and impact of cyber incidents and attacks have increased manifold in the recent past, more so in the case of the financial sector, including UCBs, RBI said in its document 'Technology Vision for Cyber Security for Urban Cooperative Banks 2020-2023'.

It has, therefore, become essential to enhance the security posture of UCBs to prevent, detect, respond to and recover from cyber-attacks, the central bank said. (Read more)

Who: World Tourism Day 2020

World Tourism Day 2020: Livelihood of millions of people globally are dependent on tourism. There are countries where tourism and industries dependent on it are the biggest revenue earner. Travel and tourism is one of the worst-hit sectors amid the pandemic-forced sudden lockdown earlier this year. Tourism-dependent states across India like Uttarakhand, Himachal Pradesh, Kerala among others have opened up the tourism sector and relaxed Covid rules for tourists. Wearing masks and maintaining social distance are mandatory but the hassle of paperwork and online e-passes have been removed.(Read more)

What: identifies LIC, GIC, New India Assurance systemically important insurers

When: published on 26th September 2020

Regulator IRDAI has identified LIC, GIC and New India Assurance as domestic systemically important insurers (D-SIIs) and subsequently decided to subject them to enhanced regulatory supervision. The three insurers have also been asked to raise the level of corporate governance, identify all relevant risks and promote a sound risk management culture, the Insurance Regulator and Development Authority of India (IRDAI) said in a statement.

"D-SIIs will also be subjected to enhanced regulatory supervision," it added.



D-SIIs refer to insurers of such size, market importance and domestic and global inter-connectedness whose distress or failure would cause a significant dislocation in the domestic financial system.(Read more)

What: ink pact to increase cooperation on IPRs

India and Denmark on Saturday inked a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to increase cooperation in the area of intellectual property rights (IPRs) by exchanging best practices and collaborating in training programmes.

The two sides will draw up a biennial work plan to implement the MoU which will include detailed planning for carrying out cooperation activities, including scope of action, the Commerce and Industry Ministry said in a statement.

The MoU aims to increase IP cooperation between the two countries by way of exchange of best practices, experiences and knowledge on IP awareness among authorities, businesses and research and educational institutions, and collaboration in training programmes, exchange of experts, technical exchanges and outreach activities.(Read more)

What: establish sub working group on defence industrial cooperation

When: published on 25th September 2020

India and Israel have established a sub working group (SWG) on defence industrial cooperation, the Defence Ministry said on Friday.

"The main objective of the SWG will be transfer of technology, co-development and co-production, artificial intelligence, innovation and joint export to friendly foreign countries," the ministry said in a statement.

The formation of the SWG was announced at a webinar, which was held on Thursday, it said.

"Defence secretaries and other senior MoD (Ministry of Defence) officials from both the countries participated in the webinar and spoke about enhancing the defence cooperation between both the nations," the statement said.(Read more)



Who: US

What: moves to restrict stay of Chinese journalists to 90 days

When: published on 26th September 2020

The Trump Administration is seeking to restrict the stay of journalists from China in the US to just 90 days with the provision of another extension for a similar duration, according to a federal notification.

The proposal of the Department of Homeland Security is part of the fixed time limit on visas of students, researchers and foreign journalists in the US.

While the time limit for foreign journalists in general has been restricted to 240 days and another extension of a similar period, those for a journalist from China would be issued a I visa by the United States just for 90 days, as per the federal notification issued on Friday.

Stake holders have 30 days to respond to the federal notification before it can be enforced.(Read more)

What: approves 200 million dollar loan for safe water & sanitation in Bangladesh

When: published on 26th September 2020

The World Bank (WB) has approved a 200 million dollar loan for Bangladesh to improve access to safe water and sanitation services in the rural areas of the country. The Bangladesh Rural Water, Sanitation and Hygiene project will help 6 lakh people to have access to clean water through piped water schemes in rural areas.

According to a Press Release issued by the World Bank on Friday, the project will also provide sanitation services to over 3.6 million rural people in Bangladesh.

The WB said that the project will help prevent diseases and protect from pandemics like COVID 19 by providing better access to Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH) facilities at homes and in public places.(Read more)

Who: 'Cable Stayed Bridge' constructed across Durgam Cheruvu Lake

What: was inaugurated

When: published on 26th September 2020

Minister of State for Home G. Kishan Reddy inaugurated the new 'Cable Stayed Bridge' constructed across Durgam Cheruvu Lake along with four-lane elevated corridor connecting it with Jubilee Hills in Hyderabad last evening. The bridge is 426 metre long, including the approaches on both ends, and 25.8 metre wide, with a total of 52 stay cables. The bridge is one of longest in the country constructed at a cost of over 334 crore rupees. On the occasion, the Minister appreciated the efforts of all workers and engineers involved in the construction of the iconic bridge.

Telangana Municipal Administration and Urban Development Minister K Taraka Ramarao and Hyderabad Mayor B Rammohan also joined the formal launch.

Who: Former BJP leader Jaswant Singh

What: passes away

When: published on 27th September 2020

Former Union minister Jaswant Singh, a close associate of ex-prime minister Atal Bihari Vajpayee, died

here on Sunday following a long spell of illness. He was 82.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi and other top BJP leaders paid rich tributes to Singh, saying that he served India diligently and will be remembered for his unique perspective on matters of politics and society. Singh was cremated in Rajasthan's Jodhpur.

Singh, a former Army officer, had been ill after a fall at his home in August 2014 and was admitted to the Army Research and Referral Hospital. He had been in and out of the hospital and was admitted again in June this year. (Read more)

What: launches state-wide Smart Ration Card scheme to cover 1.41 cr NFSA beneficiaries

When: published on 12th September 2020

Punjab Chief Minister Captain Amarinder Singh on Saturday launched the Smart Ration Card scheme to cover 1.41 crore beneficiaries across the state and a separate state-funded scheme to provide subsidised rations to the 9 lakh beneficiaries not covered under the National Food Security Act (NFSA).

As per the release issued by the state government, while rolling out the Smart Ration Card Scheme under which 37.5 lakh cards will be distributed to the eligible beneficiaries this month, the chief minister said that with this, the total number of beneficiaries in the state will go up to 1.50 crore.

"Centre had capped the maximum number of beneficiaries to 1.41 crore and, despite repeated requests, had not agreed to provide subsidized rations to the deserving 9 lakh people not covered under NFSA. Punjab government had therefore decided to cover all such left out eligible persons under a State-funded scheme, details of which will be announced shortly," he said.

Launching the Smart Ration Card scheme virtually, with connection to 100 places across the state, the Chief Minister said the scheme would help curb corruption and give freedom to the beneficiaries to buy from any depot.(Read more)

What: announced relaxations in its quarantine rules for air travellers coming from other states

When: published on 26th September 2020

The Assam government on Friday announced relaxations in its quarantine rules for air travellers coming from other states. Travellers who are cured of Covid -19 and have a negative certificate or discharge certificate from hospitals would no longer need to undergo any test or quarantine on arrival. Health minister Himanta Biswa Sarma said, "Recovered Covid patients now need no further testing or quarantine on arrival in Assam. Negative passengers would no longer need 10 days of quarantine. This decision has been taken on the basis of scientific evidence. We are the first state in the country to introduce it but it will not be applicable if the passenger has temperature and other symptoms."

The state government has developed a mobile app through which air passengers can fill up forms and show it at airports to avoid delay in completing formalities for Covid-19 tests, The app named "Visitassam" has been developed to ensure that proper social distancing is maintained. (Read more)
