Senior officials of India, the US, Japan and Australia on Friday held a virtual meeting under the framework of Quadrilateral coalition or "Quad", focusing on ways to promote peace, security, stability and prosperity in the Indo-Pacific region. The meeting took place in the backdrop of China's growing military assertiveness in the Indo-Pacific region.

The foreign ministers of the four member nations of the "Quad" are set to hold talks in Tokyo next month to further boost their cooperation in the Indo-Pacific.

In a statement, the Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) said the officials reaffirmed their commitment towards a "free, open, prosperous and inclusive" Indo-Pacific region based on shared values and principles and respect for international law.(Read more)

Who: COVID-19: MUI

What: collaborates with UN body to help Indian seafarers stranded on ships

When: published on 27th September 2020

Against the backdrop of the COVID-19 pandemic leaving around four lakh global seafarers, including thousands of Indians, stranded on ships, India's oldest union of merchant navy officers MUI has collaborated with the United Nations to assist these sailors.

The Seafarers Crisis Action Team (SCAT) has been established by the International Maritime Organisation (IMO), a specialised UN agency and a global standard-setting authority of safety, security and environmental performance of international shipping.

"The COVID-19 pandemic has put seafarers around the world in precarious situations. Some 4 lakh seafarers from across the globe, including thousands of Indian seafarers, are now stranded on ships and continuing to work but unable to be relieved in a deepening crew change crisis which threatens trade and maritime safety," said the Maritime Union of India (MUI).(Read more)

What: extends USD 15 mn assistance to Sri Lanka for promoting Buddhist ties

When: published on 26th September 2020



Prime Minister Narendra Modi announced a grant assistance of 15 million dollars to Sri Lanka for the promotion of Buddhist ties between India and Sri Lanka.

Briefing the media this afternoon, Joint Secretary (Indian Ocean Region) in the External Affairs Ministry Amit Narang said the grant will assist in deepening people-to-people linkages between the two countries in the sphere of Buddhism.

PM Modi and his Sri Lankan counterpart Mahinda Rajapaksa held the first-ever India-Sri Lanka Virtual Bilateral Summit on Saturday. They agreed that the Indian side would facilitate the visit of a delegation of Buddhist pilgrims from Sri Lanka in the first inaugural flight to Sacred City of Kushinagar. Kushinagar Airport was designated as an international airport recently recognizing its importance as a Buddhist site. Both sides also agreed to explore opportunities in the areas of Ayurveda and Yoga. (Read more)

What: launches Destination North East-2020 to promote region's tourism, culture and business

When: published on 27th September 2020

Coinciding with World Tourism Day, Union home minister Amit Shah on Sunday inaugurated Destination North East 2020, a four-day festival to promote and showcase the region's tourism, culture, heritage and business.

The inauguration took place through video conferencing and was attended by Union minister for development of north east region (DONER) Jitendra Singh and the chief ministers of Assam, Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Meghalaya, Tripura, Nagaland and Sikkim.

"I have been to several places within the country and abroad and visited many tourist destinations. But I don't think I have seen such natural beauty in any place except northeast," Shah said.(Read more)

In a first, India Happiness Report has been released. As per the report, Mizoram has been ranked the happiest state, followed by the Andaman and Nicobar Islands and Punjab. Gujarat and Uttar Pradesh also made it to the top 10 happiest states in India. Chhattisgarh, Odisha and Uttarakhand ranked at the bottom in the said report.

It is for the first time in the country that all the states and Union Territories were included in the Happiness Survey. The report was prepared by Professor Rajesh K Pillania, who is one of the leading management strategy experts of the country.(Read more)

Who: Nagaland

What: Launches Portal for Livelihood Generation Programme for Returned Migrant Workers

When: published on 28th September 2020

Following the COVID-19 outbreak, thousands of migrant workers across the country were left unemployed. The state of Nagaland registered 15,019 of such migrant workers who returned back to the state out of a total of around 27,000 returnees.

To address the issue, the department of Industries and commerce launched the portal of the Livelihood generation programme for returned migrant workers due to COVID-19 pandemic. Initiated by the department of industries and commerce and funded by the North Eastern Council (NEC) Shillong, the programme aims to support 100 new enterprises by year end.

The portal was launched by Adviser Industries & Commerce , Labour & Employment , Skill Development & Entrepreneurship Imnatiba at the Secretariat in Kohima on Monday. Towards this programme, the NEC has sanctioned Rs 2.40 crore for implementation.(Read more)

What: launches Stage II of Jaga mission for urban slum dwellers

When: published on 28th September 2020

Odisha chief minister Naveen Patnaik Monday launched the next stage of JAGA Mission – the slum upgradation and de-listing initiative.

This slum upgradation and de-listing initiative, aims to improve the living conditions of 18 Lakh slum dwellers by providing them with piped water supply, paved roads, storm water drains, street lights, sanitation, household electricity, community spaces and recreational areas. But more importantly, it encourages the participation of the slum dwellers themselves in the upgradation process.

The process shall start immediately in 1000 slums and then scaled up to cover each and every slum in the state within a period of 3 years to make the state slum free.(Read more)

Who: Andhra CM Jagan Mohan Reddy

What: to launch YSR Jala Kala scheme

When: published on 28th September



To benefit the small and medium farmers who have no open water source for irrigation, Chief Minister YS Jagan Mohan Reddy will launch YSR Jala Kala on Monday. Under the scheme, borewells will be dug free of cost to the needy farmers. The scheme is estimated to bring in five lakh acres under cultivation through groundwater irrigation.

During his 3,648-km padayatra, Jagan met farmers, whose fields were parched due to lack of water sources. They explained how they were being pushed into debts by drilling borewells. After seeing their distress, Jagan promised to provide borewells to farmers having fields in uplands and included the same in the Navaratnalu (nine promises made by the YSRC before the elections). Who: World Heart Day 2020

What: was observed on September 29

World Heart Day is annually observed on September 29 around the globe in an effort to raise public awareness about cardiovascular diseases, their prevention and global impact. Cardiovascular diseases (CVDs) claim the lives of around 17.9 million people each year, as per data collected by the World Health Organisation (WHO), and it results in 31% of all global deaths. These diseases, which manifest primarily as heart attacks and strokes, are triggered by excessive use of tobacco, unhealthy diets, a lack of physical activity and alcohol abuse. All of these unhealthy lifestyle choices result in raised blood pressure, elevated blood glucose, overweight and obesity, and risks detrimental to good heart health.(Read more)

29 September observed as a International Day of Awareness on Food Loss and Waste Reduction every year globally. In 2020 first ever observance of the day by the Food Agriculture Organization, United Nations. It was designated by the United Nations in 2019.

New Delhi residence of Singh, who is the Lok Sabha MP from Lucknow.

"We have often heard there is no age limit to learn and write, and if anybody has lived this quote in spirit and in letter, it is Dr Krishna Saksena. With her book, Dr Saksena has proved that age is just a number. And I can say with complete faith that in her book one shall find morals spread across three

generations that are relevant till date," said Singh at the launch. (Read more)

Who: Syeda Anwara Taimur, only woman CM of Assam

What: passes away at 84 due to cardiac arrest

Syeda Anwara Taimur, the only woman to have held the post of chief minister of Assam, passed away

at age 84 due to cardiac arrest, according to several media reports.

She was living in Australia for the last four years.

Taimur occupied the chief minister's office from December 1980 to June 1981 as a member of the Congress, as per a report in Indian Express. She was elected to the state's Legislative Assembly in

1972, 1978, 1983 and 1991, and held a ministerial berth twice, as per the report.

She was also a member of the Rajya Sabha twice: in 1988 she was nominated to the Upper House,

while in 2004 she was elected. Taimur joined the AIUDF party in 2011. (Read more)

The appointments Committee of the Cabinet on Monday approved the appointment of P D Vaghela, a 1986-Gujarat cadre Indian Administrative Officer (IAS), as the next chairperson of the Telecom

Regulatory Authority of India (Trai).

Vaghela, who succeeds incumbent chairperson R S Sharma, has been appointed for a period of three

years, or until he attains the age of 65, according to an official notification.



Vaghela is currently serving as the secretary of the Department of Pharmaceuticals under the Ministry of Chemicals and Fertilisers, where he took charge on August 1 last year. The Gujarat-cadre IAS officer had also been instrumental in the roll-out of Goods and Services Tax (GST) in 2017 and has served as the commissioner of commercial tax in his home state. (Read more)
