Merchants will no longer have to pay any Merchant Discount Rates (MDR) on UPI transactions below the ticket size of Rs 100 that are done through QR code 'scan and pay', effective October 1, the National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI) said.

This is expected to encourage small grocery stores, chemists and kirana stores across the country to set up basic acceptance infrastructure such as QR code to receive payments made through UPI.

Furthermore, the MDR has been revised to 0.30 percent of the transaction size for with a maximum cap of Rs.100 per transaction. As per the current regime, the rates are capped at 0.25% for transactions up to Rs. 2,000 and at 0.65% for transactions above Rs 2,000.

Bangladesh has signed an agreement to buy 718 megawatts of electricity from India's Reliance Power over the next 22 years, the company said.

Reliance plans to invest about \$1 billion to set up a local plant by 2022 to provide the electricity. The plant will be built at Meghnaghat in Narayanganj, over 20 km southeast of the capital Dhaka, according to a project report seen by Reuters at an event held to close the deal.

The combined-cycle power plant will be fueled by gas and regasification liquefied natural gas and be fully owned by Reliance.

Bangladesh agreed a deal with China last week to build renewable energy projects providing 500 megawatts by 2023 at an investment cost of \$400 million, in the latest sign of Beijing's growing role in the South Asian nation's energy sector.
