Explanations:

1.

Kolleru Lake is one of the largest freshwater lakes in India located in state of Andhra Pradesh and forms the largest shallow freshwater lake in Asia. It is located between Krishna and Godavari deltas. The lake was declared as a wildlife sanctuary in November 1999.

Hence, option C is correct.

2.

Wular Lake (also spelt Wullar) is one of the largest fresh water lakes in Asia. It is sited in Bandipora district in the Indian state of Jammu and Kashmir. The lake basin was formed as a result of tectonic activity and is fed by the Jhelum River.

Hence, option B is correct.

3.

Loktak Lake is the largest freshwater lake in Northeast India and is famous for the phumdis (heterogeneous mass of vegetation, soil and organic matter at various stages of decomposition) floating over it. The lake is located near Moirang in Manipur and located on this phumdi, Keibul Lamjao National Park is the only floating national park in the world. The park is the last natural refuge of the endangered Sangai (State Animal).

Hence, option E is correct.

4.

Harike Wetland also known as "Hari-ke-Pattan" with the Harike Lake is the largest wetland in northern India in Ferozpur district of the Punjab. The wetland and the lake were formed across the Sutlej river in 1953.

Hence, option C is correct.

5.

Pushkar Lake or Pushkar Sarovar is located in the town of Pushkar in Ajmer district of the Rajasthan. It is a sacred lake of the Hindus and describe it as "Tirtha-Raj and relate it to the creator-god Brahma. The Pushkar Lake finds mention on coins as early as the 4th century BC.

Hence, option C is correct.

6.

Ansupa Lake is a horseshoe shaped fresh water lake on the left bank of the Mahanadi river opposite Banki in Cuttack district of Odisha.

Hence, option B is correct.

7.

Tso Lhamo Lake is referred as Choramoo or Choram lake. It is one of the highest lakes in the world located at an altitude of 5,330m and situated in North Sikkim. It is fed by waters from Zemu glacier, Kangtse glacier or Pauhunri glacier and is the source of the Teesta river.

Hence, option C is correct.

8.

Sharang Pani Lake is situated in Bhopal of Madhya Pradesh.

Hence, option A is correct.

9.

Bhimtal Lake is a lake in the town of Bhimtal in Nainital district of Uttarakhand with a masonry dam built in 1883 creating the storage facility. It is the largest lake in Kumaon region and known as the "lake district of India". There is an island at the centre of the lake which has been developed as a tourist attraction and has an aquarium.

Hence, option C is correct.

10.

Lonar Lake is a notified National Geo-heritage Monument saline soda lake located at Lonar in Buldhana district of Maharashtra. It was created by a meteor impact during the Pleistocene Epoch and it is the only known hyper velocity impact crater in basaltic rock anywhere on Earth. This lake is both saline and alkaline in nature.

Hence, option D is correct.
