**Explanation:**

1. Shondol is famous dance which used to be performed by artists for King of Ladakh on special occasions. It is known as the 'royal dance of Ladakh.'

Hence, Option C is correct.

2. Panthi Dance, Folk Dance of Chhattisgarh is one of the important dance forms of Chhattisgarh State of India. This Indian folk dance is prominent ritual of the Satnami community of Chhattisgarh. The community celebrates the anniversary of the birth of Guru Ghasidas on Maghi Purnima. The panthi is performed on this day.

Hence, Option B is correct.

3. Tippani dance is a traditional folk dance of the West Indian state of Gujarat. It is also known as 'Matla Dance' or 'Tippani Nritya'. This dance form is practiced during the time of Hindu festivals such as Holi and Diwali or during the wedding ceremonies in the Gujarati community. Moreover, Garba, Dandiya Rass, Gomph are also the dance forms of Gujarat.

Hence, Option C is correct.

4. Ghoomar is a traditional as well as an enthusiastic folk dance of Rajasthan. Ghoomar or Ghumar was basically developed by the Bhil tribe and was adopted by other Rajasthani communities. The Ghoomar dance is a particularly a women's dance and performed by the women for exclusively ladies gatherings.

Hence, Option A is correct.

5. Charkula dance has been originated and owes its birth to Krishna era. This popular dance is well known in Braj city of Uttar Pradesh and is even widely performed in Madhya Pradesh. This folk dance is connected with the myths of lord Krishna and his surrounding life. Rasa Lila Dance, Chappeli, Khayal, Nautanki, Naqaal, Swang, Dadra are also performed in UP.

Hence, Option D is correct.

6. Povadas are presented in the Marathi ballads form. This dance form describes the events in the life of the great Maratha ruler, Shri Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj. Other dance forms of Maharashtra are Lavani Dance, Dhangari Gaja, Koli Dance, Tamasha, Dindi Dance, Kala Dance, etc.

Hence, Option B is correct.

7. Santhali dance is a popular folk dance practiced by Santhal tribes in Jharkhand. This dance form has attained popularity all across India and also has been featured in many reputed Bengali cinemas like 'Agantuk' by Satyajit Ray. Goudi, Navrani, Mundari, Dagla are also famous dance forms of Jharkhand.

Hence, Option A is correct.

8. Matki Dance is mostly performed in the Malwa region of Madhya Pradesh, India. It is a solo dance performed by ladies on special occasions like weddings, birthdays, or any other special occasion. Jawara, Tertali, Grida, Maanch are also popular dance of MP.

Hence, Option B is correct.

9. Chang Lo or Sua Lua is a traditional dance of the Chang tribe of Nagaland state. Similar to the Zeliang dance, this tribe is gracefully performed with men and women both geared up with traditional war weapons like dao, shield and spear.

Hence, Option D is correct.

10. It is performed in the Hindu community of Goa and is performed in the month of March. Temples are decorated in this time while a festival of the same name, Shigmo and the dance is performed to appease the Gods. Dekhinni, Mandi, Khol are also popular dances of Goa.

Hence, Option C is correct.
