Explanation:

1. Bathukamma is floral festival celebrated predominantly by the Telangana. Every year this festival is celebrated as per Shathavahana calendar for nine days starting Bhadrapada Pournami till Durgashtami.

Hence, option C is correct.

2. Elephanta festival is organized by the Maharashtra Tourism Development Corporation (MTDto promote Mumbai tourism and culture. It is one of the most prominently celebrated festivals in Mumbai. This renowned festival is held on the Elephanta Island, adjacent to the Elephanta Cave, a World Heritage Site.

Hence, option B is correct.

3. In Tripura, Lai Haraoba, a ritualistic festival is observed by Manipuri meitei communities since ancient times. Lai Haraoba is celebrated through oral literature, music, dance and rituals.

Hence, option B is correct.

4. The Chapchar Kut is a festival of Mizoram, India. It is celebrated during March after completion of their most arduous task of jhum operation i.e., jungle-clearing. It is a spring festival celebrated with great favour and gaiety.

Hence, option C is correct.

The festival of Fulpati is celebrated with traditional gaiety and religious fervour in various parts of Nepal. Fulpati is observed on the 7th day of Dashain festival. In Nepali, "Phool" means flower and "Pati" means leaves and plants.

Hence, option D is correct.

6. Shirui Lily & Sangai Festivals are annual cultural state festivals of Manipur organized by Manipur Tourism Department every year. The 'Sangai Festival' is named after the State animal, Sangai, the brow-antlered deer found only in Manipur.

Hence, option C is correct.

7. The Madhavpur Mela of Porbandar, Gujarat shares its connect to the Mishmi Tribe of Arunachal Pradesh. The festival celebrates the immortal journey which Rukmini undertook from Arunachal Pradesh to Gujarat with Lord Krishna.

Hence, option B is correct.

8. The Kala Ghoda Arts Festival is annual festival, nine days long, commencing always on the first Saturday of February and closing always on the second Sunday in February, in the Kala Ghoda area of South Mumbai, India.
