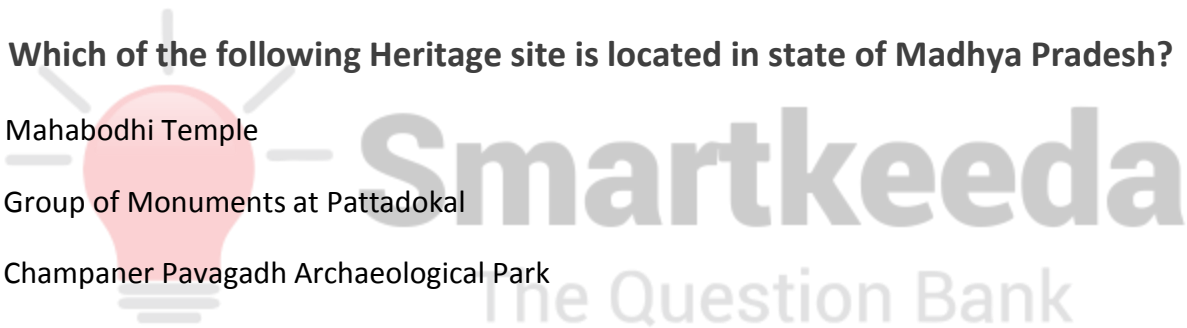

Elephanta Caves are a UNESCO World Heritage Site and a collection of cave temples predominantly dedicated to the Hindu god Shiva. They are located on Elephanta Island in Mumbai Harbour. In 1987, Elephanta Caves were designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Hence, option B is correct.

2.

Khajuraho Group of Monuments located in the Indian state of Madhya Pradesh. It was inscribed by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site, a cultural property on October 15, 1982.

Hence, option D is correct.

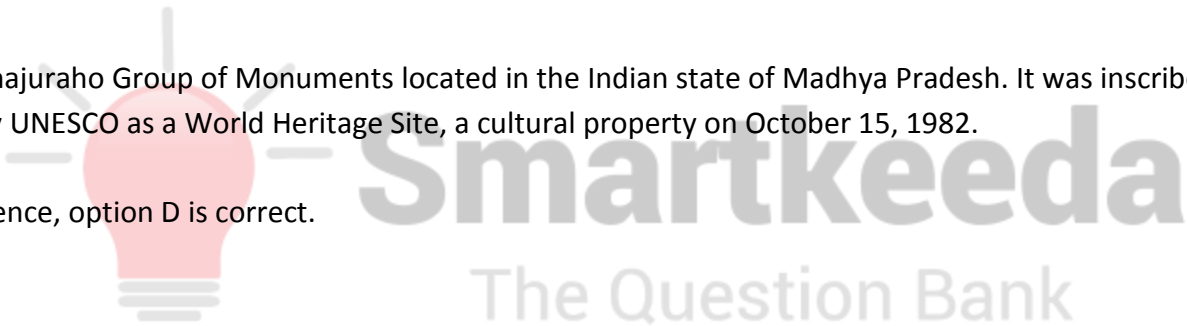

Group of Monuments at Hampi is a UNESCO World Heritage site located in the Northern part of Karnataka. It lies within the ruins of the ancient, prosperous kingdom of Vijayanagar. The ruins at Hampi are a collection of heritage sites depicting the fine Dravidian style of art and Architecture.

Hence, option D is correct.

The Sundarbans National Park is the largest mangrove forest in the world, a tiger reserve and a biosphere reserve located in the Sundarbans Ganges river delta bordering the Bay of Bengal in West Bengal. It was inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage list in 1987 as a natural property.

Hence, option B is correct.

Rock Shelters of Bhimbetka is a magnificent repository of rock paintings within natural rock shelters” located in the foothills of the Vindhya Range of hills in the Central Indian state of Madhya Pradesh. It was inscribed as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 2003 as a unique cultural property.

Hence, option D is correct.

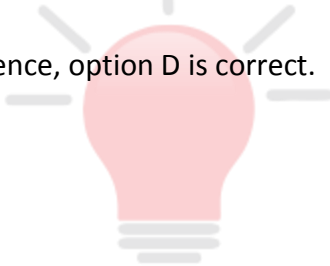
