1.

Chapramari Wildlife Sanctuary is close to the Gorumara National Park. It is about 30 km from Chalsa and Lataguri in northern West Bengal. The name comes from 'Chapra', a variety of small fishes found in northern Bengal, and 'Mari' meaning 'abundance'. In 1998, it has been given the status of a national wildlife sanctuary. Chapramari is known for its elephant population.

Hence, option C is correct.

2.

Bornadi Wildlife Sanctuary is situated in the foothills of Himalayas bordering Bhutan in the north and in Udalguri district & Baksa District of Assam. This sanctuary is named after the river Bornadi. The sanctuary was established in 1980 to protect the mammals' hispid hare and pigmy hog.

Hence, option B is correct.

3.

Nargu Wildlife Sanctuary lies across the Uhl River in Mandi District of Himachal Pradesh.

Hence, option A is correct.

4.

Dampa Tiger Reserve or Dampha Tiger Reserve is the largest wildlife sanctuary in Mizoram. It was notified in 1985 and declared a Tiger Reserve in 1994. Dampa Tiger Reserve is the natural home of leopards, Indian bison, barking deer, sloth bear, gibbons, langurs, Indian Python.

Hence, option C is correct.

Ngengpui Wildlife Sanctuary and Khawnglung Wildlife Sanctuary are in Mizoram.

Melghat Wildlife Sanctuary is situated in Maharashtra.

Hence, option E is correct.

6.

Dalma Wildlife Sanctuary is located 10 km from the city of Jamshedpur in the Indian state of Jharkhand. It was inaugurated by Sanjay Gandhi in 1975. It contains significant population of Indian Elephants.

Hence, option A is correct.

All of the three Nandini Wildlife Sanctuary, Ramnagar Wildlife Sanctuary and Limber Wildlife Sanctuary are in state of Jammu and Kashmir.

Hence, option E is correct.

Hastinapur Wildlife Sanctuary lies on the western bank of the Ganga River. It was founded in 1986 in Meerut, Muzzafarnagar, Ghaziabad, Bijnor, and Amroha districts of Uttar Pradesh, India. It is a large sanctuary.

The population of the wild animals includes various species of animals including antelope, sambhar, cheetal, blue bull, leopard, hyena, wild cat, and different types of birds.

Hence, option A is correct.

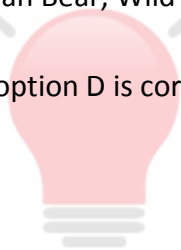

Binsar Wildlife Sanctuary is perfect place for Bird watchers as trekking is allowed in forest and one can watch plenty of Birds and Animals during trekking in forest. The Binsar Wildlife Sanctuary is famous as the home of leopard, Black Himalayan Bear, Wild boars, Kakars, Monkeys Red Fox, and Jackals.

Hence, option D is correct.
