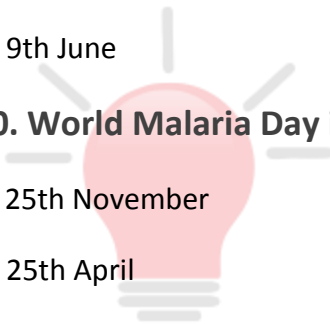

1.

To enroll new voters and encourage them to take part in the political process, Government of India has decided to celebrate January 25 every year as 'National Voters' Day'. It started from January 25th 2011 to mark Commission's foundation day.

Hence, option B is correct.

2.

World Environment Day (WED) is celebrated on the 5th of June every year, and is the United Nation's principal vehicle for encouraging awareness and action for the protection of our environment. First held in 1974, it has been a flagship campaign for raising awareness on emerging environmental issues from marine pollution, human overpopulation, global warming and wildlife crime

Hence, option D is correct.

3.

September 16 was designated by the United Nations General Assembly as the International Day for the Preservation of the Ozone Layer. This designation had been made on December 19, 2000, in commemoration of the date, in 1987 on which nations signed the Montreal Protocol on Substances that Deplete the Ozone Layer.

Hence, option C is correct.

4.

On 20 December 2013, at its 68th session, the United Nations General Assembly (UNGA) decided to proclaim 3 March as World Wildlife Day, the day of the adoption of the Convention

on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora (CITES). It was proposed by Thailand to celebrate and raise awareness of the world's wild fauna and flora.

Hence, option E is correct.

**5.**

International Day of Yoga, or commonly and unofficially referred to as Yoga Day is celebrated annually on 21 June since its inception in 2015. An international day for yoga was declared unanimously by the United Nations General Assembly (UNGA). The Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi in his UN address suggested the date of 21 June, as it is the longest day of the year in the Northern Hemisphere and shares special significance in many parts of the world

Hence, option D is correct.

**6.**

National Science Day is celebrated in India on 28 February each year to mark the discovery of the Raman effect by Indian physicist Sir Chandrasekhar Venkata Raman on 28 February 1928.

Hence, option B is correct.

**7.**

The National Sports Day in India is celebrated on 29 August each year. This day marks the birthday of Dhyan Chand the hockey player who won gold medals in Olympics for India.

Hence, option D is correct.

**8.**

Earth Day is an annual event celebrated on April 22. Worldwide various events are held to demonstrate support for environmental protection. First celebrated in 1970, Now Earth Day events in more than 193 countries.

Hence, option A is correct.

**9.**

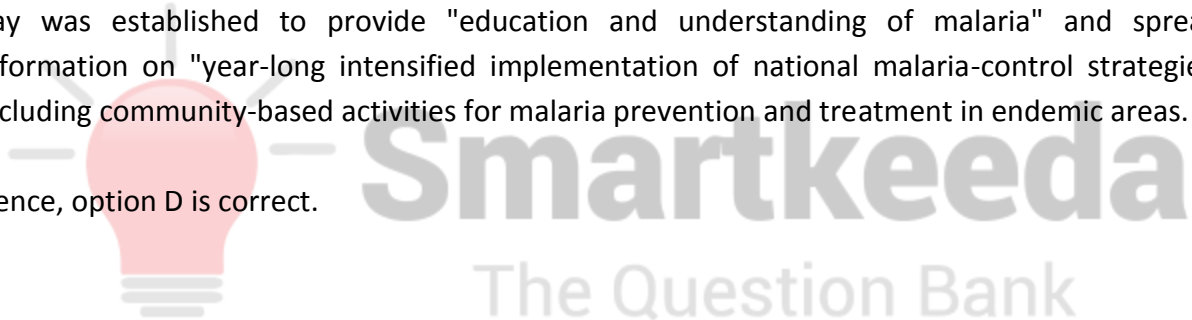
World Oceans Day takes place every 8 June. It has been celebrated unofficially since its original proposal in 1992 by Canada's International Centre for Ocean Development (ICOD) and the Ocean Institute of Canada (OIC) at the Earth Summit – UN Conference on Environment and Development (UNCED) at Rio de Janeiro in Brazil

Hence, option C is correct.

**10.**

World Malaria Day (WMD) is an international observance commemorated every year on 25 April and recognizes global efforts to control malaria. World Malaria Day was established in May 2007 by the 60th session of the World Health Assembly, WHO's decision-making body. The day was established to provide "education and understanding of malaria" and spread information on "year-long intensified implementation of national malaria-control strategies, including community-based activities for malaria prevention and treatment in endemic areas."

Hence, option D is correct.
