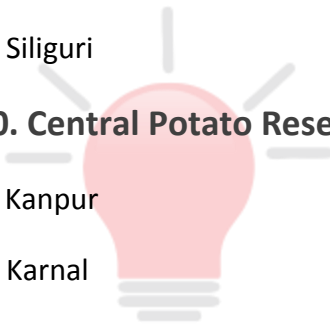

Explanations:

1.

In 1945, the Government of India decided to establish a central Institute for rice research. As a result, the Central Rice Research Institute (CRRI) was setup on 23 April 1946 at Bidhyadharpur, Cuttack, Odisha. In 1966, the administrative control of the institute was transferred to the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR).

Hence, option C is correct.

2.

National Institute of Nutrition (NIN) was founded by Sir Robert McCarrison in the year 1918 as 'Beri-Beri' Enquiry Unit at the Pasteur Institute, Coonoor, Tamil Nadu. Within a short span of seven years, this unit blossomed into a "Deficiency Disease Enquiry" and later in 1928, emerged as "Nutrition Research Laboratories" (NRL). It was shifted to Hyderabad in 1958. In 1969, it was renamed as National Institute of Nutrition (NIN).

Hence, option B is correct.

3.

The Indian Institute of Remote Sensing is a premier institute for research, higher education and training in the field of Remote Sensing, Geoinformatics and GPS Technology for Natural Resources, Environmental and Disaster Management under the Indian Department of Space, which was established in the year 1966. It is located in the city of Dehradun, Uttarakhand.

Hence, option A is correct.

4.

Sugarcane Breeding Institute (SBI) is a central research institute in Coimbatore, India. It was established in 1912 and is affiliated to Indian Council of Agricultural Research. It was established to promote research efforts in sugarcane production and is the only sugarcane research institute in the country

Hence, option B is correct.

5.

The National Dairy Research Institute was established at Bangalore in 1923 as Imperial Institute of Animal Husbandry and Dairying. In 1936 it was renamed as Imperial Dairy Institute. In 1947 it was renamed to its current name. In 1955 the institute's headquarters moved to Karnal. The status of deemed to be university was conferred to the institute in 1989.

Hence, option C is correct.

6.

Central Fuel Research Institute (CFRI) is based in Dhanbad, Jharkhand, India. It is a constituent laboratory of Council of Scientific & Industrial Research (CSIR), an autonomous government body and India's largest research and development (R&D) organization.

Hence, option B is correct.

7.

National Institute of Securities Markets (NISM) is an Indian public trust and an educational institute and staff college of SEBI established in 2006 by the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) the regulator for the securities market in India. The institute offers academic programmes, training programmes, capacity building and skill development programmes in securities markets. The institute is located in Vashi, Navi Mumbai, India.

Hence, option C is correct.

8.

Central Drug Research Institute (CDRI) is a multidisciplinary research laboratory in Lucknow, India, employing scientific personnel from various areas of biomedical sciences. CDRI was formally inaugurated on 17 Feb 1951 by the then Prime Minister of India, Jawahar Lal Nehru.

Hence, option A is correct.

9.

National Institute of Homeopathy was established on 10 December 1975 in Kolkata as an Autonomous Organisation under the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of India. It is affiliated to the West Bengal University of Health Sciences and conducts the degree course in Homeopathy

Hence, option C is correct.

10.

The institute was established in August 1949 at Patna. Three small units under the IARI looking after potato, namely Potato Breeding Station at Shimla, Seed Certification Station at Kufri, and Potato Multiplication Station at Bhowali were merged with the newly created Central Potato Research Institute (CPRI). The headquarter of the institute was shifted to Shimla, Himachal Pradesh in 1956.

Hence, option E is correct.
