## Explanation:

### 1. Statements:

100% Pen are Phones

Only 5G is Phones



### Conclusions:

I. All 5G being Phone is a possibility

II. All phones are Pen

Checking C1: All 5G being Phone is a possibility

We can observe that "All 5G being Phone is a possibility" is a true possibility as no negative statement is given which can make this statement false. Therefore, C1 follow.

Checking C2: All phones are Pen

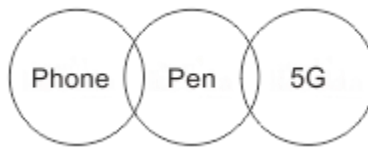
We can observe that, all Pens are Phones from Venn diagram. Therefore, C2 does not follow.

Option A is hence the correct answer.

### 2. Statements:

34% Pens are Phones

90% 5G are Pens



**Conclusions:**

I. All Phones can be 5G

II. All Pen can be phones

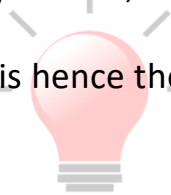
Checking C1: All Phones can be 5G

We can observe that “All Phones can be 5G” is not a definite conclusion but a true possibility. Therefore, C1 follows.

Checking C2: All Pen can be phones

We can observe that “All Pen can be phones” is not a definite conclusion but a true possibility. Hence, C2 follows.

Option C is hence the correct answer.

**3. Statements:**

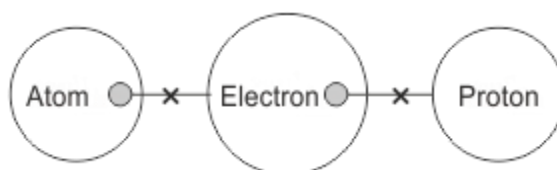
100 % Atoms are not Electron

**Conclusions:**

Checking C1: Some Atoms are Proton

We can observe that 'Some Atoms are Proton' is not a definite statement. Therefore, C1 does not follow.

Checking C2: No Atom is Proton

We can observe that 'No Atom is Proton' is not a definite statement. Therefore, C2 does not follow.

In both S1 and S2 all elements are same and statements are contradictory. Therefore either or case is possible.

Option D is hence the correct answer.

**4. Statement:**

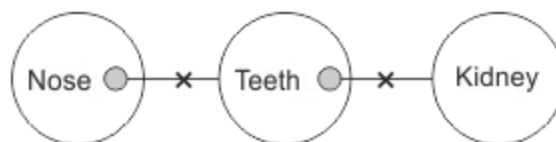
10 % noses are not teeth

15 % teeth are not kidney

**Conclusions:**

I. All noses are kidney

II. Some noses are not kidney



Checking C1: All noses are kidney

We can observe that 'All noses are kidney' is not a definite statement. Therefore, C1 does not follow.

Checking C2: Some noses are not kidney

We can observe that 'Some noses are not kidney' is not a definite statement. Hence, C2 does not follow.

In both S1 and S2 all elements are the same and statements are contradictory. Therefore either or case is possible.

Option D is hence the correct answer.

## 5. Statements:

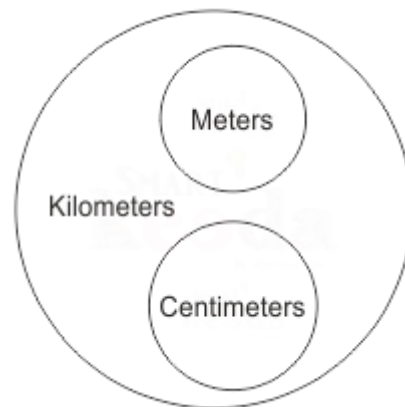
Only Kilometers are Meters means All Meters are Kilometers

Only Kilometers are Centimeters means All Centimeters are Kilometers

## Conclusions:

I. All Meters can be Centimeters

II. No Meter is Centimeter



Checking C1: All Meters can be Centimeters

We can observe that 'Only Kilometers are Centimeters' that means no other element can be centimeter. Therefore, C1 does not follow.

Checking C2: No Meter is Centimeter

We can observe that, 'Only Kilometers are Centimeters' that means no other element can be centimeter. Therefore, C2 follow.

Option B is hence the correct answer.

**6. Statements:**

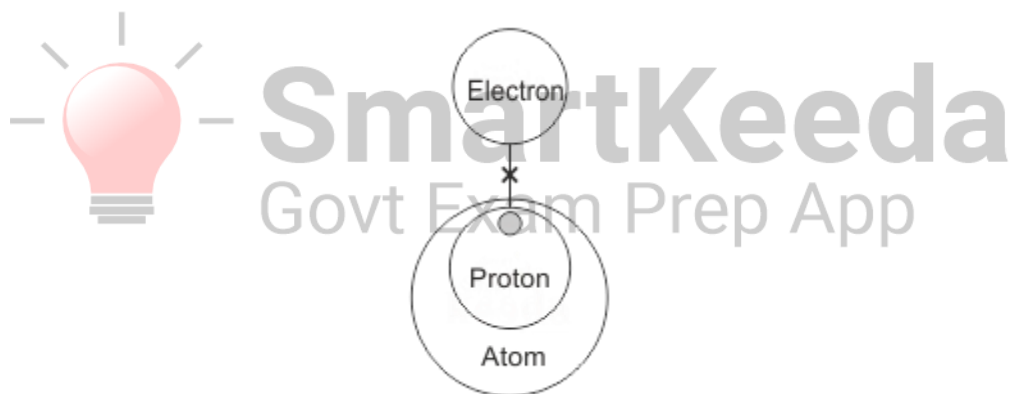
100 % Protons are Atoms

few Protons are not Electron

**Conclusions:**

I. Some Atoms are not Electrons

II. Some Atoms are Electrons



Checking C1: Some Atoms are not Electrons

We can observe that only few Protons are not Electron and all Protons are Atoms. Thus few Atoms are definitely not Electrons. Therefore, C1 follow.

Checking C2: Some Atoms are Electrons

We can observe that few Protons are not Electron but we can not definitely say that Some Atoms are Electrons. Therefore, C2 does not follow.

Option A is hence the correct answer.

**7. Statements:**

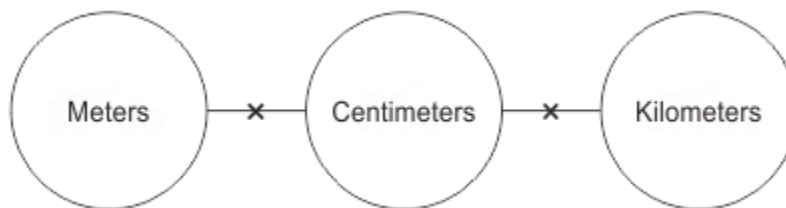
No Meter is Centimeter

No Centimeter is kilometer

**Conclusions:**

I. All Meters are kilometer

II. Some Meters are kilometer



Checking C1: All Meters are kilometer

We can observe that 'All Meters are kilometer' is not a definite statement because no direct relation is known. Therefore, C1 does not follow.

Checking C2: Some Meters are kilometer

We can observe that 'Some Meters are kilometer' is not a definite statement because no direct relation is known. Therefore, C2 does not follow.

Option E is hence the correct answer.

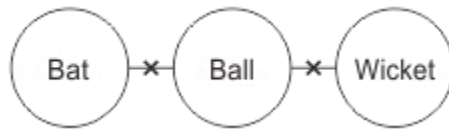
**8. 100% bat are not balls**

100% Balls are not wickets

**Conclusions:**

I. few bat are not wickets

II. Few bat are wickets



**Checking C1:** few bat are not wickets

We can observe that, no relation is given between bat and wickets, thus 'few bat are not wickets' cannot be true. Therefore, C1 does not follow.

**Checking C2:** Few bat are wickets

We can observe that, no relation is given between bat and wickets, thus C2 cannot be true. Therefore, C2 does not follow.

As we know **few** and **few not** complementary pairs to each other and both the elements are same in both conclusions. So, Either C1 or C2 is correct.

Hence, option D is the correct answer.

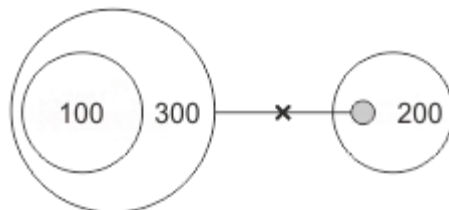
9.  Few 200 are not 300

Only 300 are 100

**Conclusions:**

I. No 100 can be 200

II. Some 200 can be 300



Checking C1: No 100 can be 200

We can observe that only 300 can be 100, no other element can be 100. Therefore, C1 follows.

Checking C2: Some 200 can be 300

We can observe that, few 200 are not 300, thus remaining 200 can be 300. Therefore, C2 follows.

Hence, option C is the correct answer.

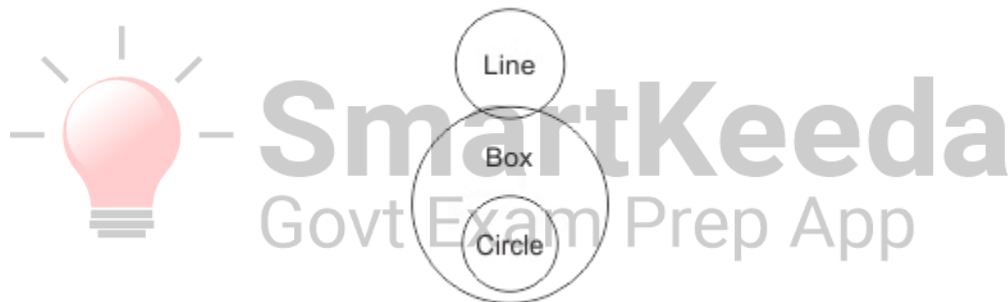
10. 'Only Boxes are circles' means all circled are boxes

Only few lines are boxes

**Conclusions:**

I. All lines are not boxes

II. Few lines can be circles



**Checking C1:** All lines are not boxes

We can observe that, only few lines are boxes, thus all lines cannot be boxes. Hence conclusion is true. Therefore, C1 follows.

**Checking C2:** Few lines can be circles

We can observe that, only boxes are circles so no other element can be circle. Therefore, C2 does not follow.

Hence, option A is the correct answer.
