## Explanation:

1. The phrase "Me Too' are' needs a verb which should be in either third form or in continuous form. Any plural noun will also work but '**process**' is neither of these. Besides, the context talks about the 'Me Too' and controversies associated with it.

So, we need a word with 'controversies' which should mean something like association and among two options **surrounding** and **complicated**, the former fits into the context. Consequently, 'A' must be replaced by 'C' and 'B' with 'D' (as 'D' is the only letter left which can replace 'B').

Evidently, option D is the correct answer.

2. We need a verb after noun 'INS Viraat' to make sentence meaningful and we have only one verb among all bolded words which can replace 'A', i.e. **came**. So, we need to replace 'A' with 'D' and the rest two are placed at their correct places and need not any changes.

Thus, option D is the correct answer.

3. Looking at 'A' and 'B', 'these **acts**' sound more genuine than 'these **government**' as 'these' needs a plural noun. So, 'B' and 'A' should interchange their original places and 'transform **private** agriculture' does not make any sense and this ensures the third letter in the sequence to be 'D' as 'transform **Indian** agriculture' seems logical and makes 'C' to be the fourth letter in it.

Evidently, option A is the correct answer.

4. Going as per the given sequence, '**warnings**' are not sold logically and following this pattern only, either '**cigarettes** (D)' or '**products** (B)' is sold but there is no 'D' in the first place of the sequence and this ensures 'B' to be the first letter of the sequence as it should be replaced with 'A' because 'health **warnings**' make sense.

Besides, the phrase 'do not' requires a verb and '**cigarettes**' are not a verb. This makes 'C' to be the fourth and 'D' to be the third letter respectively in the sequence.

Evidently, option B is the correct answer.

5. There is no need to rearrange any word from their already positioned places as they are contextually and grammatically correct by all means.

Thus, option E is the correct answer.

6. Looking at 'A' and 'B' 'our **farmers** are agitating' sounds more genuine than 'our **favour** are agitating' as latter one is contextually meaningless. So, 'B' and 'A' should interchange their original places and rest two letters are correctly placed and need not any changes.

Evidently, option A is the correct answer.

7. The phrase 'six have been **names**' is grammatically and contextually incorrect and needs a verb after 'been' and the only word which can suit our requirement is **arrested** and this means 'A' must be replaced with 'B' and the sequence must become '**BA**' initially.

Besides, the phrase 'was filed **others** the NIA court' is contextually incorrect and this needs a replacement with '**before**'. This gives the final sequence to be **BADC**.

Evidently, option B is the correct answer.

8. There is no need to rearrange any word from their already positioned places as they are contextually and grammatically correct by all means.

Thus, option E is the correct answer.

9. The phrase 'Brown was **months**' is grammatically and contextually incorrect and demands a replacement. We need a verb which must be in continuous form here and **living** can fit into the context easily and this means 'B' must come at the first position in the final sequence.

Out of given all options, only 'option B' has 'B' at desired place.

Furthermore, the phrase 'for the past six **months**' makes more sense than 'for the past six **spread**' or 'for the past six **cancer**'. Putting 'A' at third position and **spread** at fourth, the complete sequence of option B becomes valid.

Evidently, option B is the correct answer.

10. The phrase 'the **them**' requires a noun and this makes a replacement of 'A' with 'D' as 'D' fulfils the requirement. Besides, 'not only **stopped**' seems more logical than 'not only **cowardly**' and this makes the final sequence to be DCBA.

Evidently, option C is the correct answer.
