> Synonyms: Free, independent, isolated Antonyms: United, connected, associated

Clearly option B united expresses the opposite meaning of the given sentence.

Hence option B is correct.

2. The bold word "remove" means to get rid of or to end something.

Synonyms: Stop, Abolish, End

Antonyms: Initiate, Incorporate, Add

Clearly option C incorporate(to form or constitute) expresses the opposite meaning of the given

sentence.

Hence option C is correct.

3. The bold word "boost" means to enhance or advance.

Synonyms: Raise, Magnify, Uplift

Antonyms: Impede, Reduce, Decrease

Thus, clearly option A impede(to hinder) expresses the opposite meaning of the given sentence.

Hence option A is correct.

4. The bold word "infringed" means to enter without permission or to enter a restricted place.

Synonyms: Infringe, Trespass, Impinge

Antonyms: Escape, Exit, Retreat

Thus, clearly none of the options expresses the opposite meaning of the given sentence.

Hence option E is correct.

5. The bold word "continue" means to persist in any activity.

Synonyms: Persist, Ongoing, Sustain

Antonyms: Cease, halt, stop

Thus, clearly option B expresses the opposite meaning of the given sentence.

Hence option B is correct.

6. According to the given statement, the first part is regarding the thought that came to my mind and the second part is regarding the effectiveness of the though.

Option A is not correct since it is not the exact sentence as the given one and that is why it can be eliminated.

Option B is also not correct since it means something else as compared to the given statement. It talks about the outcome to be befogged whereas the actual statement is regarding the mind being befogged.

Option D is also incorrect since it is also not the same as the given statement and hence can be eliminated from the consideration of the correct choice.

Option C is the correct choice since it correctly expresses the same meaning as the given statement and also the opposite word of the bold word has been used in this statement.

This makes option C the correct choice among the given options.

Synonyms: Enjoy, Adore, Appreciate

Antonyms: Dislike
